

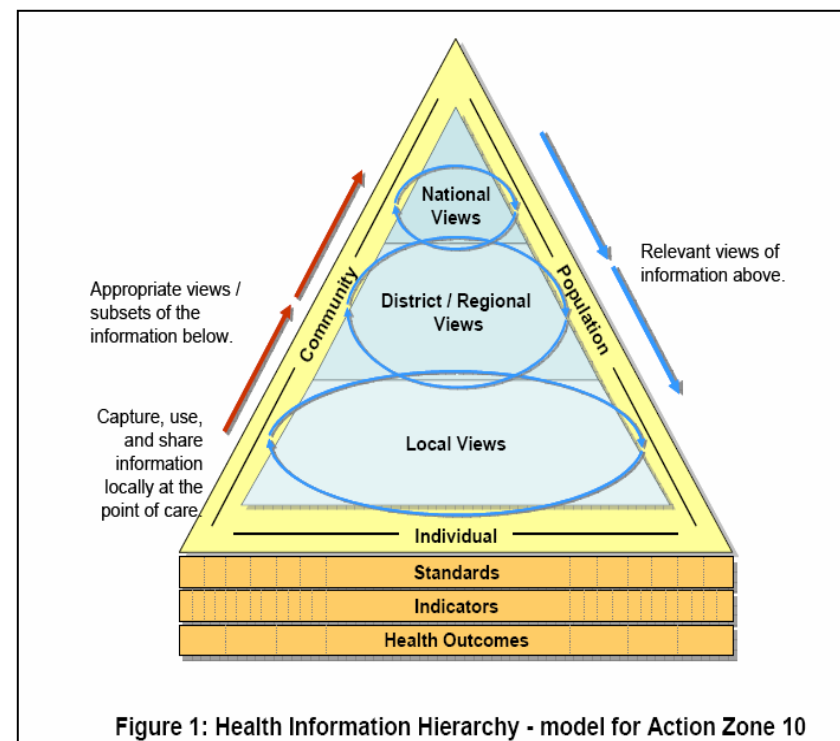
AZ10 – Primary Care Information

Future State Features

- ☞ Patients and primary care practitioners reliably access individual health information needed for decisions about care and self management
- ☞ Primary care teams, PHOs and other stakeholders are able to demonstrate improvements in health care quality and outcomes for their respective populations
- ☞ Local capture and use of standardised primary health care information is a part of normal activities and appropriate subsets of local information are available regionally and nationally allowing access to health event summaries in accordance with the Health Information Privacy Code and the wishes of the individual.

This roadmap focuses on:

- ☞ Distributed health information / detail according to the decisions that need to be made.
- ☞ Appropriate views / subsets within and between different levels of the sector.
- ☞ Evidence based improvement and improved clinical governance.
- ☞ Co-ordination of care between health and disability service providers.
- ☞ Increasing overall information systems participation and capability in the wider primary care sector.
- ☞ Appropriately standardised data achieved through good system design and defined data sets.

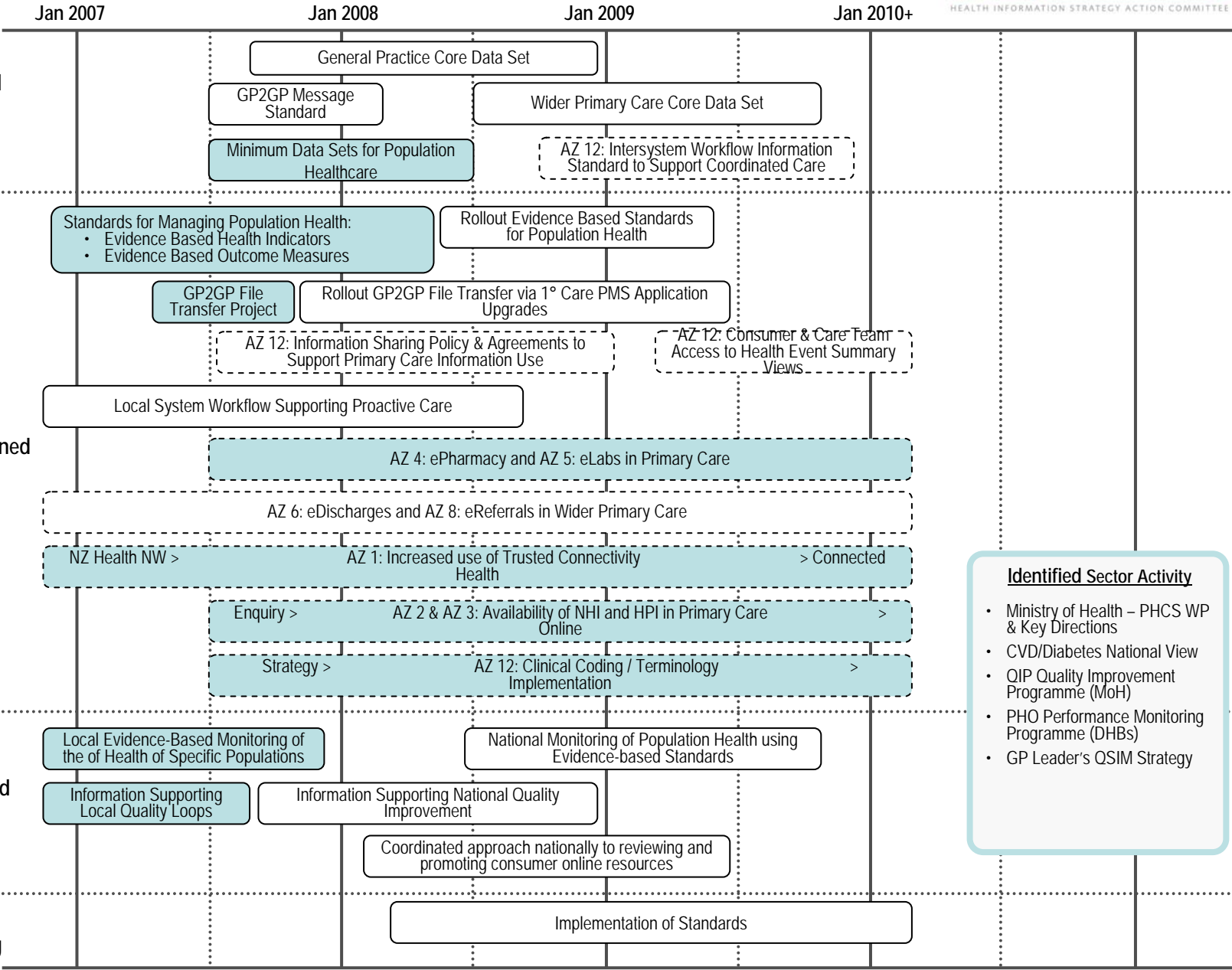


AZ 10: Primary Care Information
